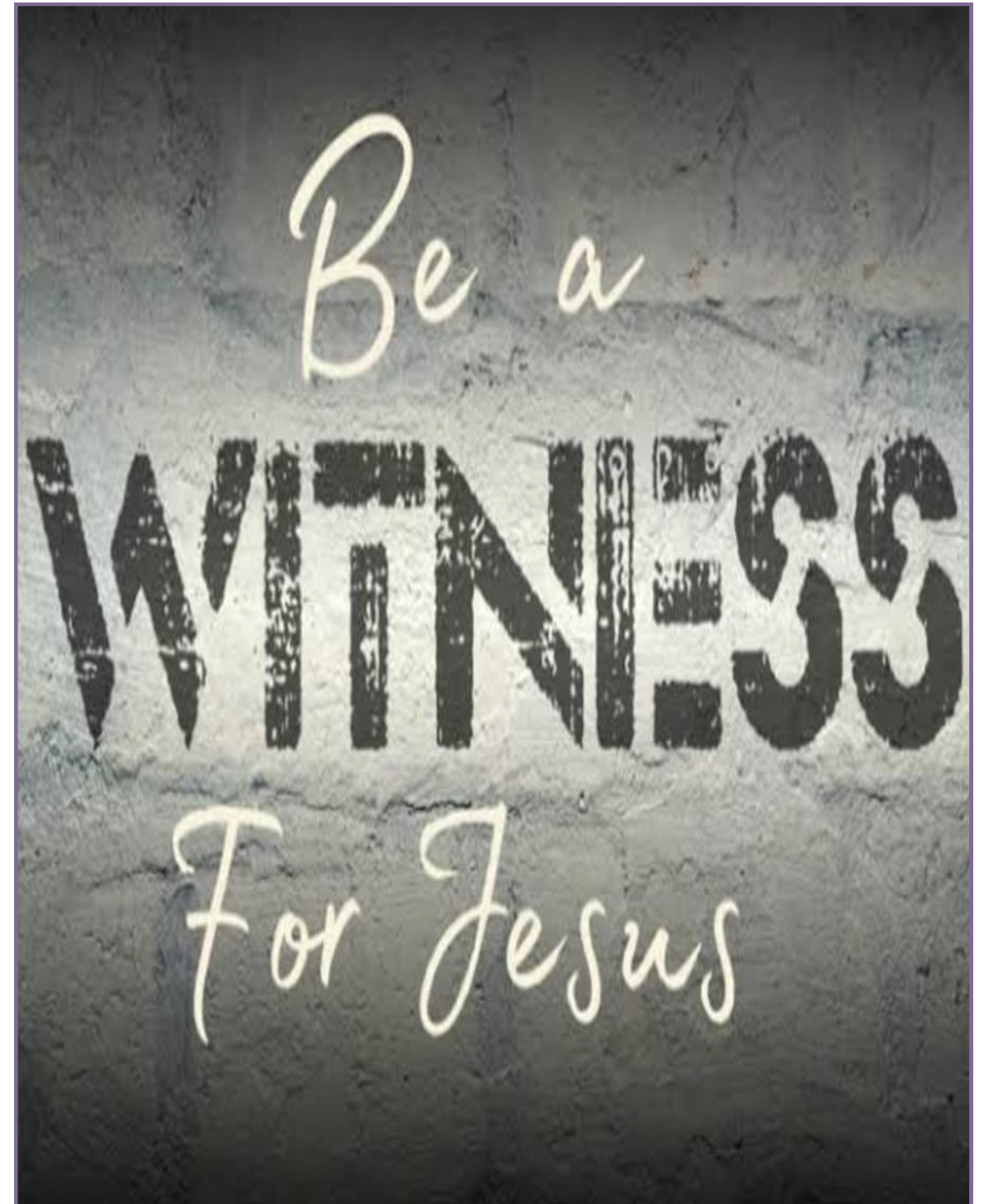

Nothing Bundt Cakes

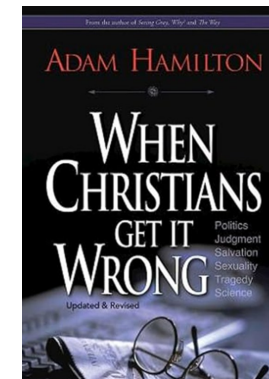
