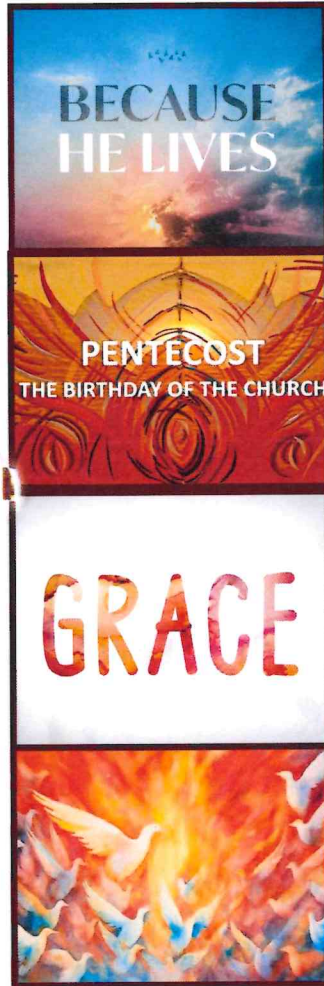
## Because He Lives... We Also Shall Live

*“They devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer... And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.” – Acts 2:42, 47*

Pentecost is often celebrated as “the birthday of the Church,” but it is more than a moment in Church history; it is an ongoing movement of the Holy Spirit. What began with divine wind and tongues of fire – filling ordinary people with extraordinary grace – is still unfolding today in and through the life of the Church. This year, we see that movement clearly in the lives of Calvary’s Confirmation Class.

Throughout this Eastertide, we have been walking together through the series, *Because He Lives*. This series is rooted in Jesus’ promise: “*Because I live, you also will live*” (John 14:19). We have reflected on how resurrection is both something we celebrate and something we inherit by grace through faith in Jesus Christ. The resurrection changes everything. It includes you and me, and it propels us into becoming. Likewise, the Day of Pentecost helps us see the path where the resurrection journey leads:

**Belong. Believe. Become. Bless.**

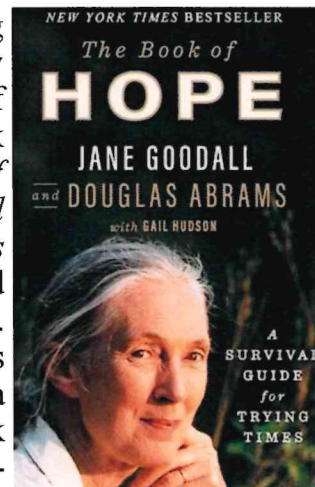

## RECYCLING AT CALVARY

If you ever place recyclable items in our Recycling Dumpster, please be sure to read this notice:

**Reminder! NO plastic bags may be placed in Calvary's Recycling Dumpster.** There are fines from the recycling site where our trash haulers deliver our recyclables which our hauler will pass on to the church if plastic bags are in the container. There are cameras on the trucks to monitor what is in our container and we will be fined \$165 if there are plastic bags, even just one.

**If you are taking recyclables out to the dumpster you must place the items so that they are loose in the dumpster and not within a plastic bag.** Allowable recyclables are: newspaper, cardboard (boxes must be broken down), glass jars or bottles, aluminum & tin cans, hard plastic bottles, jugs & jars (#'s 1, 2 or 5 only). ### Home Repair Volunteers Needed

God's Helping Hands (GHH) is a faith-based home repair ministry, serving the greater Harrisburg area since 2011 that was founded by Aldersgate United Methodist Church (Mechanicsburg, PA). Their mission is to practice the teachings of Jesus by providing home and property maintenance and repairs for people in need.

In 2025, GHH served 8 homeowners with 154 volunteer work days on a variety of projects, including three ramps.

Projects are typically done over 3-day work weekends, scheduled several times throughout the year. Volunteers of any skill level are always needed and welcome, experience is not required.

As a reminder, please notify the church office if your address or phone number has changed. The Post Office charges a fee for any returned mail. Thank you!

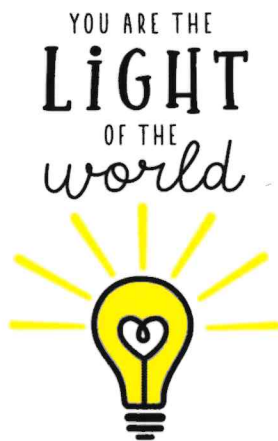
